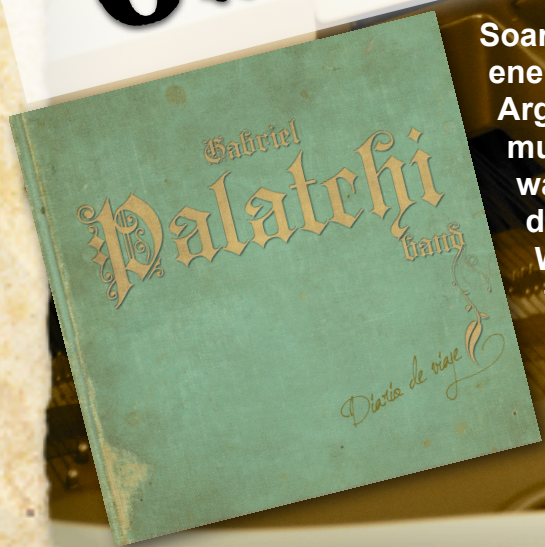




Gabriel Palatchi Band

Bio:

Gabriel Palatchi was born in August 3, 1982 in Buenos Aires, Argentina. At the age of 8, he started his first piano lessons. He then went on to study classical music at the conservatory Manuel de Falla school in Argentina. His studies led him to a Musical Production degree. He further expanded his studies with a degree in music from the Berklee international School. During this time he studied under many great maestros of Blues, Tango, Jazz and Latin Jazz. After graduation, in 2008, he packed up his piano and started to travel to expand on his musical studies and experiences. These travels continuous today. It was in Cuba where he met and studied with several maestros including the master "Chucho" Valdez. He continued his travels to Mexico, where he continued to expand on his musical studies and experience. These experiences led to the composition and production of his first solo CD entitled "Diario de Viaje" (Travel Diary).

His CD was chosen as one of the best Latin Jazz CD's of the 2010 by the JAZZ FM TORONTO Cafe Latino 91.1.
